Dear Randels Families,

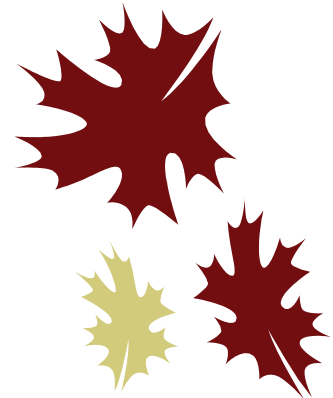
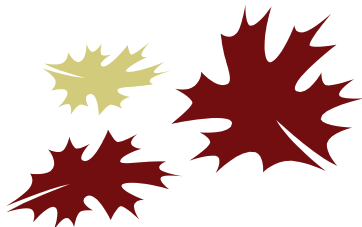
